Intro	<p>For the next few weeks we will be looking at the story of David in the old testament. Last term we looked at Israel's first king, Saul. He was the sort of king the people wanted – strong, tall and impressive...but he didn't always trust God – he thought he was tough enough to cope on his own. God had other ideas and chose a shepherd boy to be king instead...Today we will be watching a video of the story of David's life.</p>
